She majored in Art at Queens College in Charlotte and also holds a Paralegal Certificate from Meredith College. She has done graduate work at UNC-Charlotte and UNC-Greensboro.

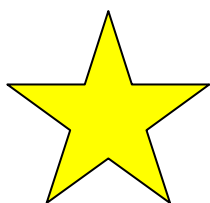

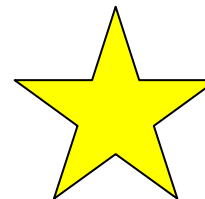
